General Data Protection Regulation

Stoxkarts Ltd. are asking for your consent to hold information for the right to use your name, race number, photographs or video footage, or addresses of yourself for the purpose of advertising or publicity as Stoxkarts Ltd. see fit.

By signing below, you agree to Stoxkarts Limited to hold your information and use for purposes as detailed above. In the case of drivers under 18 this consent should be signed by the Parent/Guardian who has signed the SX/4 Consrnt form.

RULES OF RACING

- 1) A driver will be held responsible for his or her mechanics or helpers at all time. Drivers will be bound by the decision of the officials in all matters. These two items are a condition of booking.
- 2) PPE that complys with Stoxkarts Limited rules must be worn.
- 3) Shatterproof goggles or a shatterproof visor MUST be worn with the helmet at all times.
- 4) All Flag signals must be obeyed immediately. Red – Stop. Green – Start/Go. Waved Yellow – No Overtaking, walking pace speed. Stationary Yellow – Caution. Chequered Flag – Race Winner. Black Flag – Disqualified, pull off the track immediately.
White Flag with a Red Cross - You have a problem with your car and must leave the track immediately.
6. Drivers are reminded to remain in their karts whilst on the track or parked on the infield with their PPE on, arms inside the kart and belts secured unless the car is alight.
7. Drivers must comply with any reasonable instruction given by the official of the meeting; failure to do so will result in a penalty or disqualification.
8. Mechanics are only allowed onto the circuit by invitation of the clerk of the course or the racing manager, in order to take part in parade laps.
9. The use of contact is an integral part of Stoxkarts racing; Karts may use the front bumper to hit the rear bumper of the Kart in front to gain a legitimate position or spin a kart in the corner. Spinning down the straights is strictly forbidden as is follow-ins or aggressive driving, driving recklessly or in a manner deemed to be a danger to others will not be permitted and in particular, but without limitation it is not permitted to:
 - i) Make deliberate contact with another kart whilst not travelling in a racing direction.
 - ii) Make deliberate contact in such a way that the contacting kart follows the contacted kart into the safety barrier.
 - iii) Deliberately baulk a faster kart not on the same lap.
 - iv) Deliberately spin a Kart on the straights.
 - v) Hit a kart into a stationary kart.
 Front to rear contact is permitted.
10. You are not permitted to let passengers travel on your Kart.
11. Arms must be kept in the Kart at all times whilst on track.

Have read and fully understand the above Rules of racing and in addition I have also read the Stoxkarts Limited abbreviated rules and agree to abide by them in addition to the conditions set out below.

- 1) I am over 16 not over 60 years of age (If you are over 16 but under 18 you will need to complete a parental consent form SX/4 and include it with this contract)
- 2) I am fully aware that the sport of Stoxkart Racing is dangerous and agree that i shall take part in the sport of Stoxkart Racing entirely at my own risk.
- 3) I agree to abide by the rules laid down by Stoxkarts Ltd. and it's governing body the Oval Racing Council International .
- 5) Not to cause, or be part of or involved in any way with any action that would or could disrupt a race meeting. I also understand that I am responsible for the actions of my pit crew and family members, and understand that if their behaviour in any way disrupts a race meeting my license may be suspended or cancelled.
- 6) English law shall apply to this contract. Both I and Stoxkarts Ltd. agree to abide by the jurisdiction of the English Courts
- 7) That except in the case of death or personal injury caused by Stoxkarts Ltd. negligence, or as expressly provided in this Contract, Stoxkarts Ltd. shall not be liable to me by reason of any representation (unless fraudulent), or any implied warranty, condition or other term, or any duty at common law, or under the express terms of the contract, for any loss of profit or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims (whether caused by the negligence of Stoxkarts Ltd., its servants or agents or otherwise).
- 8) I further agree to save harmless and keep indemnified Stoxkarts Limited, and the respective directors, officials, members, landowners, promoters, servants, representatives and agents and/or drivers and mechanics from all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss, death or injury to myself, howsoever caused, not withstanding that the same may have contributed to, or occasioned by, the negligence of the several persons or bodies otherwise than in connection with the business or activities Stoxkarts Limited, and further to keep indemnified the said parties in respect of death, injury or loss sustained by any third party as a result of the member's negligence and/or breach of contract, save in so far as in either event the said liability is covered by a policy of insurance.

Stoxkarts Ltd. reserves the absolute right to take whatever action of disqualification as deemed to be necessary.
